



SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS

The Special Revenue Funds consist of those "restricted receipts" which may not be used for general municipal purposes. They are restricted by local ordinance, state or federal statute, to be used for specific purposes. These groups of funds represent services funded primarily by other levels of government and not "traditionally" provided by local government. Should the funding for most of these programs be eliminated, it is likely that the services would also be eliminated. Summarized below are the Special Revenue Fund appropriations.
