



TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION FOR THE EMERGENCY RESPONDER
RADIO COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE CITY OF GLENDALE

The Emergency Responder radio system operated by the City of Glendale includes:

1. 9-site simulcast Project 25 (Phase I) trunking system (increased from 6 in 2018).
2. Single-site analog conventional repeater system.
3. 6-site simulcast analog conventional repeater system.
