## Administrative Design Review

### Case No. PDR 1828095

The Director of Community Development will render a final decision on or after **March 28, 2019**, for the following project:

The applicant is proposing a one-story, 1,755 square-foot addition to an existing one-story, 828 square-foot single-family residence (originally constructed in 1945) on a 7,476 square-foot lot located in the R1 (FAR District II) Zone. The proposal also includes demolition of the existing detached garage at the rear, and a new 420 square-foot, two-car garage attached to the front of the residence.

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** The project is exempt from CEQA review as a Class 1 "Existing Facilities" exemption, pursuant to Section 15301 (e)(1) of the State CEQA Guidelines, because the proposed addition to the existing structure will not result in an increase of more than 2,500 square-feet of floor area.
