

Background

Internal Audit completed an audit of the Multi-Project Affordable Housing Lottery process (Phase I) that included a review of the application process, eligibility evaluation process, the accuracy and completeness of the final application dispositions, and the final lottery number assignments for those applicants to be included within the lottery.

Objective/Scope/Methodology

Phase II of the lottery audit focused on the completeness of printed lottery ticket numbers entered into the lottery drawing, the transparency of the lottery drawing process, and the verification of the final winning lottery number lists. These components are critical to assure that the lottery drawing is performed in a fair manner. A Lottery Process Checklist was used to ensure that controls exist to address the risks identified

The completeness of the printed lottery ticket numbers were verified.

#2

Lottery ticket numbers were safeguarded.

#3

Lottery drawing was open to the public and televised on GTV6.

#4

Lottery tickets were displayed for public inspection in the drawn order.

#5

The posted winning lottery list was verified to the physical lottery tickets.

Review Results

The lottery ticket numbers printed and included within the lottery drawing were complete and the lottery numbers drawn were recorded, and the winning numbers were posted in an accurate and timely manner.
