### Task Force Meeting Minutes November 9, 2021

Meeting Conducted via MS Teams, no votes taken.

#### Strategic Plan: (Ambrose)

- Review of status of the four plan components, communications, fireground safety, quality improvement, and emerging technologies. Updated status of each project. (Attached)

#### VFCC updates: (Ambrose)

- CAD/GIS – A hotfix software version 2.1.8.2 was deployed. Three days later VFCC experienced issues: monitors blinking, pop-ups, loss of ER Status on MDT, and others. Multiple tickets opened with Peraton for each issue. MDT will NOT receive critical updates if it is off-line (powered down, out of signal range). Agencies are reminded that MDT's require updates – information has been sent out.
- Staffing – FCO Jeff Creiman has come back to VFCC as an hourly employee. Four FCOs currently on probation until February 2022. Still have two FCO openings. Supervisor rotation and shift changes will occur in January 2022.
- A fail-over test of the network will be done tomorrow. Every major planned update or network test/upgrade will be announced to Task Force, placed on the operational and coordinated to ensure proper staffing. The system requires regular updates at both VFCC, GLN IT, and through Verizon.
- Data Update (Gor) – HBA agreement renewal is in process for completion by the end of the year. Demonstrated a few dashboards for call processing and type codes.

#### Workgroups:

- Communications Plan – Weddle – Train the Trainer will be scheduled for next week. Some CAD and MDT examples will be included in the training materials.
- Mayday/RIC – Nothing new to Report.
- QI – Nothing new to Report.
- Tech Scout – Volunteers needed. Third generation [SCOUT](#) by OES is being deployed, next week a meeting/training with OES/Contractor and Area C will be taking place in Verdugo Community room on Wednesday, 17 November. ARC will host and afternoon session.

#### Old Business:

- Standards of Command – The base model from BRK has been re-worked by several Area C Chiefs with the goal of creating a Verdugo wide document consistent with NFPA and FireScope. Changes are still being accepted up to November 19<sup>th</sup> for review by the work group.
- First Watch – The application provides an awareness dashboard for EMS with ER wait times. A technical meeting was held with VFCC staff. A barrier may be with Peraton but there is already an API for Escondido which may help get it done quicker. After the first year of deployment there will be an estimated annual cost of \$8,000.

#### New Business:

- Type Codes/Draw Down/Standards of Cover – Review of Type Code project. ArcGIS layers showing the occupancy types are still being examined as well as overhaul of type codes by the OPS committee.
- The ability to automate draw down has been added to the Type Code project. The effort is to standardize and automate draw down based on system activity using features available in CAD. For example – 4 (PRI) Apt FIRE to have Plan A (3E 2T 1ALS 1BC), Plan B(2E 1T 1ALS 1BC) & Plan C(1E/T). This would be programmed in CAD for automatic reduction in apparatus assigned to calls during times of draw down. This has been added to the Type Code project for review by OPS Chiefs.
- Contact Timer – Ambrose demonstrated examples of conflicting versions and requested modification to align with ICS 910 and ensure consistency. as having Presented language change, no vote required, group agreed on wording change. The SOG will be updated to reflect contact timer starting at initial report on conditions (whether or not smoke or fire is present).
- Earthquake Drill, Survey 123 – Overall the group agreed that the Survey123 app was helpful. Discussion on having others besides the FD use the app.

#### Major Events

- 318 N Holliston Ave incident in PAS – multiple arson fires ended in a multi-block area. Discussion on ICS options and that by occurring at shift change, VFCC was able to handle more radio traffic than normal. After any significant incident VFCC supervisors are filling out an incident form and pulling the audio. The suspect is in custody. PAS is in process of conducting an AAR.

#### Roundtable:

- BRK – Lateral recruitment in process and EMS study underway
- SPS – Nothing to report
- MPK –New station 62 is now open
- SGB – Currently running an Academy, update on new fleet
- ARC – Promoting one captain and will have engineer test in January
- PAS – 7 laterals started the 6-week academy, preparing for Rose Bowl and Rose Parade
- GLN – BC Foster is retiring next week.
