Meeting Conducted via MS Teams and in Person (Wallace and Hatch), no votes taken, recording available.

VFCC updates:

- CAD/Operations:
 - We are working on a generic MDT login to avoid using personnel as this locks user out of logging in to other apparatus.
 - Connectivity issue has continued since March 18, all of the vendors and GLN and VFCC IT are troubleshooting. Symptoms are slow map performance and/or inability to use buttons on the MDT.
 - Testing dual sim cards (T-Mobile) on MDTs.
 - GIS/address verifications are continuously tested and updated.
 - CAD for certain freeway responses is an ongoing issue, a potential solution will take staff time to program.
- Staffing: FCO bulletin going out next week. Hourly option did not work: one candidate withdrew, another failed background. We will be looking for panelists for upcoming interviews.
- Tech Committee: No updates.
- Finance/Data: Budget is in the final stage; official rates will be communicated in few weeks. No significant increase for the contracting agencies.
- GIS: Presented some layers for upcoming TC Maps. Will be installed on MDTs as well.

The deployment will be over the next few months and is fully supported by OES Director and CAL FIRE Chief. The maps, IAP's and SA available will be a very good complement to Tablet Command.
