PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Application for an Administrative Use Permit (AUP) to allow the operation of a new retail liquor store (Total Wine), which includes the sale of alcoholic beverages for off-site consumption (ABC License Type 21) and on-site tastings (ABC License Types 42, and 86) in the C2 (Community Commercial) Zone.

CODE REQUIRES

1) The operation of a liquor store requires an Administrative Use Permit in the C2 Zone (GMC Section 30.12.020, Table 30.12-A).

APPLICANT'S PROPOSAL

1) To allow the operation of a new liquor store which includes the sale of alcoholic beverages for offsite consumption and on-site tastings.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

The project is exempt from CEQA review as a Class 1 "Existing Facilities" exemption, pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(e), because the discretionary permit request is to allow for a new retail liquor store within an existing commercial space and there is no additional floor area proposed.
