PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Tentative Parcel Map GLN No. 1643 to consolidate nine (9) existing lots into one (1) lot with a combined total of 55,844 square feet. The proposed project involves demolition of the existing 17,794 square-foot one-story commercial building (retail store) and parking lot (built in 1972 and 1989) to construct a new 3-story, 90-unit (114 beds), 85,505 square-foot medical residential congregate facility with a one-level subterranean parking garage (51 parking spaces).
