PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The applicant is requesting the approval of standards and setback variances for a 14 foot, 10 inch street front setback and 14 foot, 10 inch driveway length along the northwest side of an existing 1,128 square-foot one-story, single-family residence in association with a project which includes 2,228 square-foot addition and a new 891 square-foot garage on a 15,250 square-foot lot, zoned R1 (Low Density Residential Zone), Floor Area Ratio District II.

CODE REQUIRES

- 1. A minimum 25 feet street front setback (GMC 30.11.030 Table 30.11 B).
- 2. A driveway with a minimum of 20 feet in length from the back of the property line (GMC 30.32.130(G)(4)).

APPLICANT'S PROPOSAL

Complete construction of a project that included a 2,228 square-foot addition, and an 891 square-foot garage with:

- a. Reduction of the required front setback standards to 14 feet, 10 inches.
- b. Reduction of the required driveway length standards to 14 feet, 10 inches.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

The project is exempt from environmental review as a Class 1 "Existing Facility" pursuant to Section 15301 of the State CEQA Guidelines because the proposed addition to the existing house will not result in an increase of more than 10,000 square feet and the project is in an area where all public services and facilities are available and is not located in an environmentally sensitive area.

The Planning Hearing Officer will conduct a public hearing regarding the above project at 613 E. Broadway, 2nd floor (Council Chambers), Glendale, CA 91206, on AUGUST 17, 2022, at 9:30 am or as soon thereafter as possible. The purpose of the hearing is to hear comments from the public with respect to zoning concerns. The hearing will be held in accordance with Glendale Municipal Code, Title 30, Chapter 30.36.
