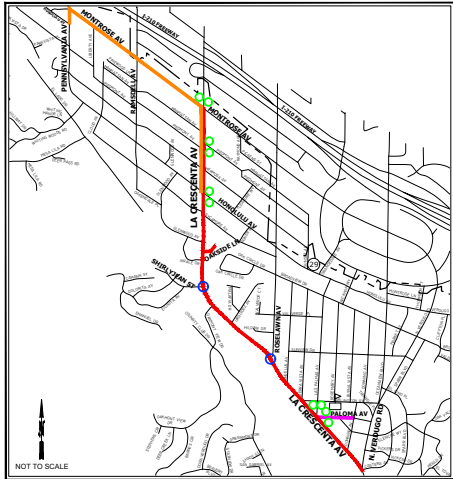

UPCOMING PUBLIC WORKS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

La Crescenta Avenue Rehabilitation Project

Project Description:

- Street pavement rehabilitation;
- Reconstruction of concrete curb and gutters, cross gutters, driveway and alley aprons, and sidewalks;
- Construction of curb ramps meeting ADA requirements;
- Planting of new trees and pruning of tree roots;
- Installation of New Bicycle Facilities and potential repurposing of roadway travel lanes to accommodate bicyclists;
- Installation of creative crosswalks, new striping, and other pavement markings;
- Modification of existing traffic signals and Installation of Fiber Optic Infrastructure;
- Reflective pavement installation;
- Installation of bio-retention facilities to capture storm water runoff.

Construction Schedule:

- Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin Spring 2023, barring any unforeseen conditions.
