- Complete a Parks Film Permit Application, and verify park/facility availability with Matt Acosta. The application can be downloaded at www.glendaleca.gov/parksfilming.
- Once your Parks site is approved, submit a FilmLA application at http://my.filmla.com.
- A site meeting may be scheduled in conjunction with the Application.
- 4. Make payment in full to City of Glendale, and receive your Parks Film Permit.
- Make payment in full to FilmLA, and receive your FilmLA Permit.
