

# Best Practices to PROTECT OUR WATERWAYS

Prevent discharges to storm drains and
 Do not expose waste or raw materials to rainwater

#### **Vehicle washing**

Prevent washwater runoff to the street, gutter or storm drain by washing vehicles in designated areas that will drain to a sanitary sewer connection.





#### Wet sanding and grinding

Prevent washwater runoff from wet sanding and grinding by working in designated areas that will drain to a sanitary sewer connection.





#### **Spill prevention**

Prevent spills by maintaining vehicles and equipment. Place drip pans under leaking vehicles and equipment. Keep spill kit in the work area.





## Spill clean up

Clean spills by sweeping, applying absorbent or spot treating with a mop.

Do not let wash-water pool or flow offsite.





### Auto chemical storage and disposal

Vehicle fluids should be stored off the ground, in covered containers and in areas where they will not be exposed to rainwater.





#### **Auto part storage**

Oily auto parts such as engines and transmissions should be stored off the ground, covered and in areas where they will not be exposed to rainwater.
