



Best Practices to PROTECT OUR WATERWAYS

- ✔ Prevent discharges to storm drains and Do not expose waste or raw materials to rainwater

Vehicle washing

Prevent washwater runoff to the street, gutter or storm drain by washing vehicles in designated areas that will drain to a sanitary sewer connection.



Wet sanding and grinding

Prevent washwater runoff from wet sanding and grinding by working in designated areas that will drain to a sanitary sewer connection.



Spill prevention

Prevent spills by maintaining vehicles and equipment. Place drip pans under leaking vehicles and equipment. Keep spill kit in the work area.



Spill clean up

Clean spills by sweeping, applying absorbent or spot treating with a mop. Do not let wash-water pool or flow offsite.



Auto chemical storage and disposal

Vehicle fluids should be stored off the ground, in covered containers and in areas where they will not be exposed to rainwater.



Auto part storage

Oily auto parts such as engines and transmissions should be stored off the ground, covered and in areas where they will not be exposed to rainwater.
