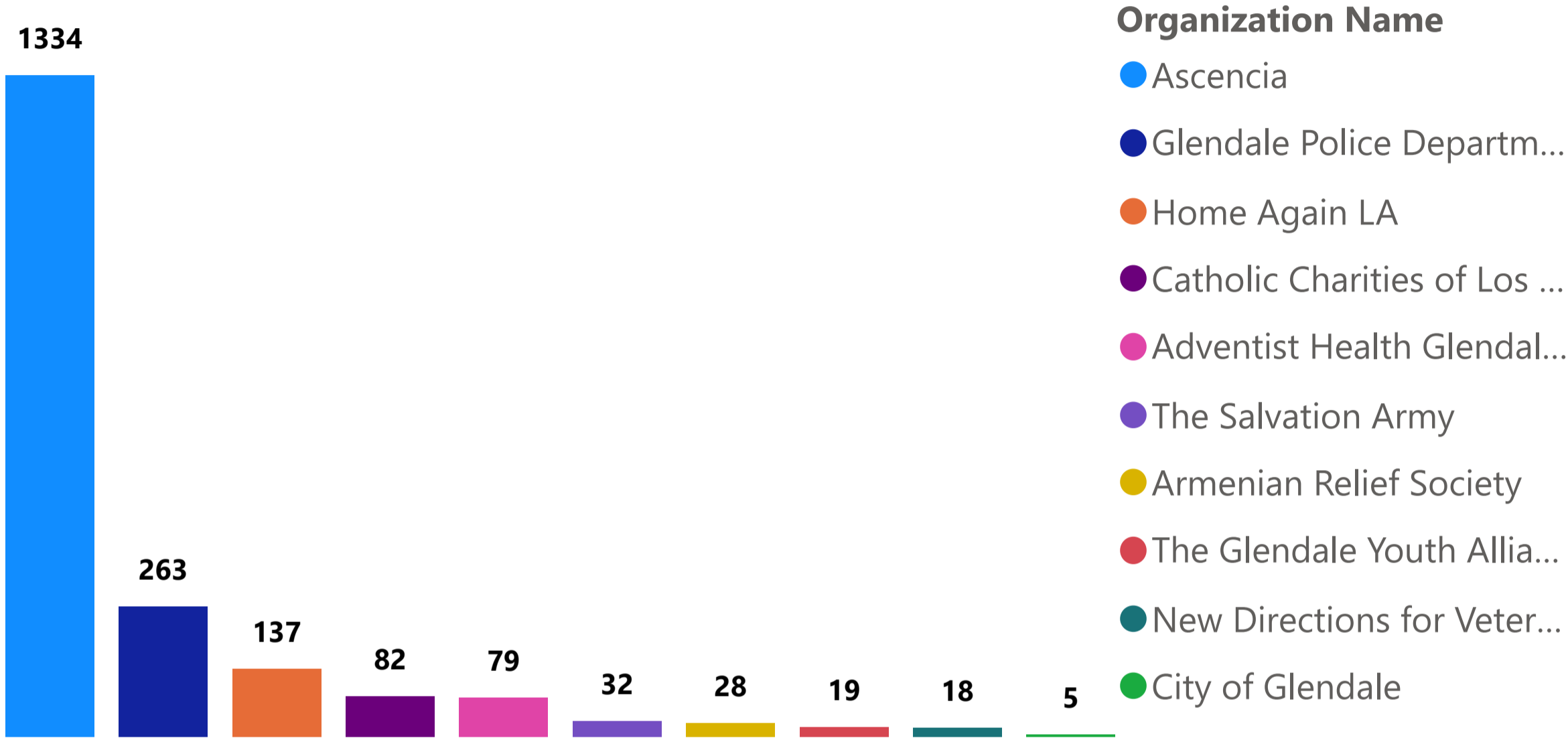

## Total Served By Agency



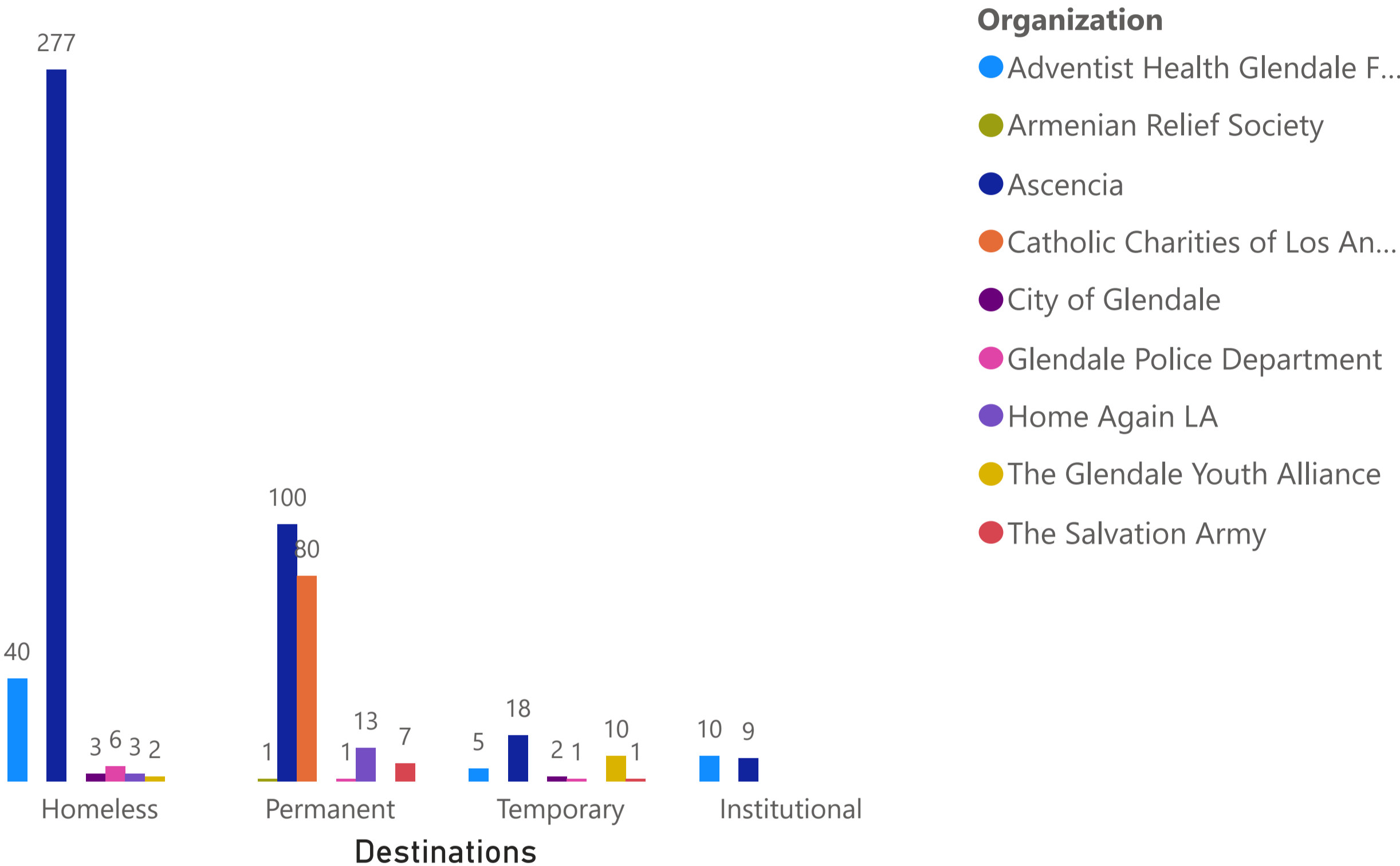

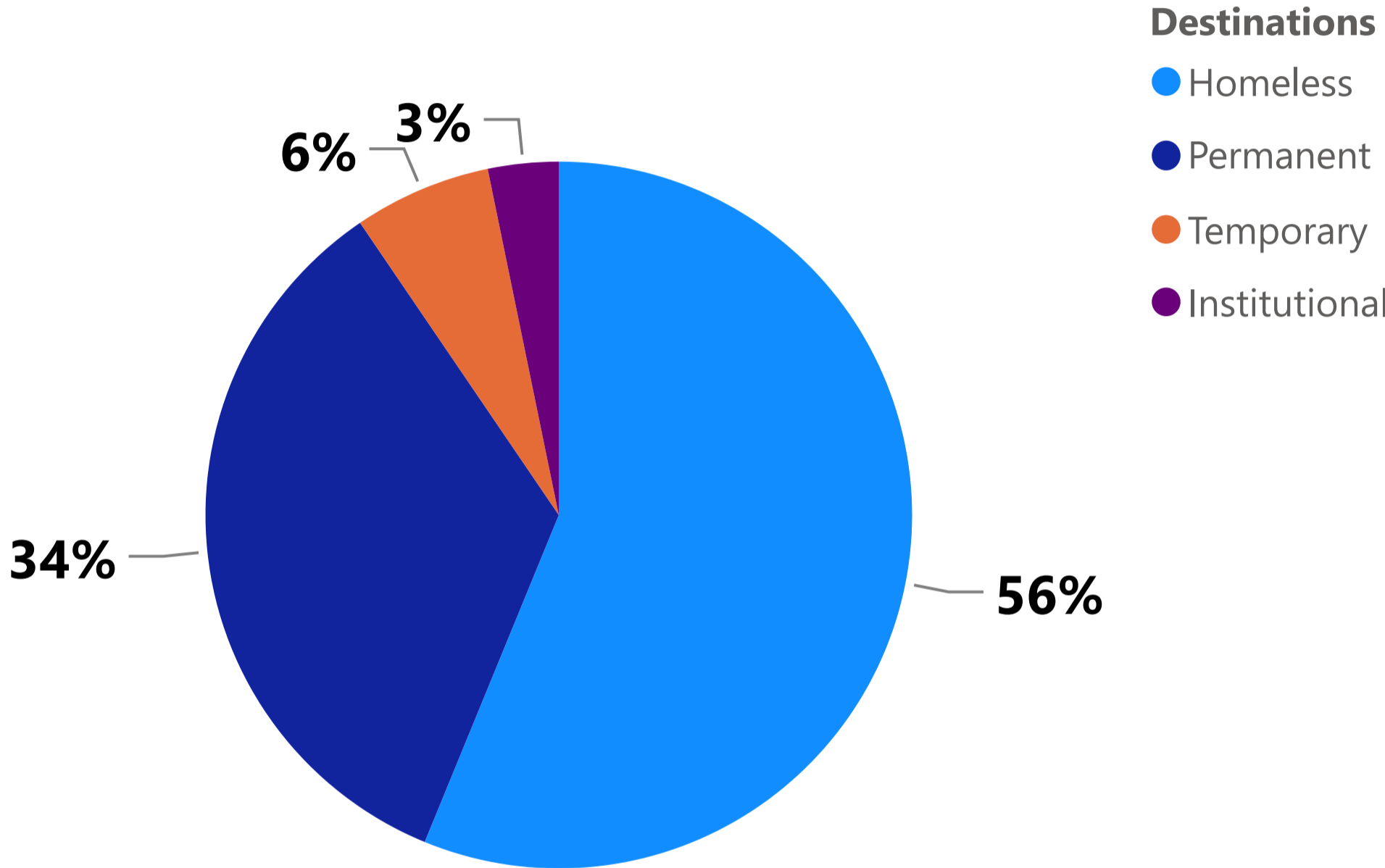

## CY 2021

### Black, African American, or African

**18.6%** (n = 69) moved into Permanent Housing destinations  
**24.9%** (n = 310) in the System

### White, Hispanic/Latinx

**38.8%** (n = 144) moved into Permanent Housing destinations  
**31.8%** (n = 396) in the System

### Asian or Asian American

**2.7%** (n = 10) moved into Permanent Housing destinations  
**2.6%** (n = 32) in the System

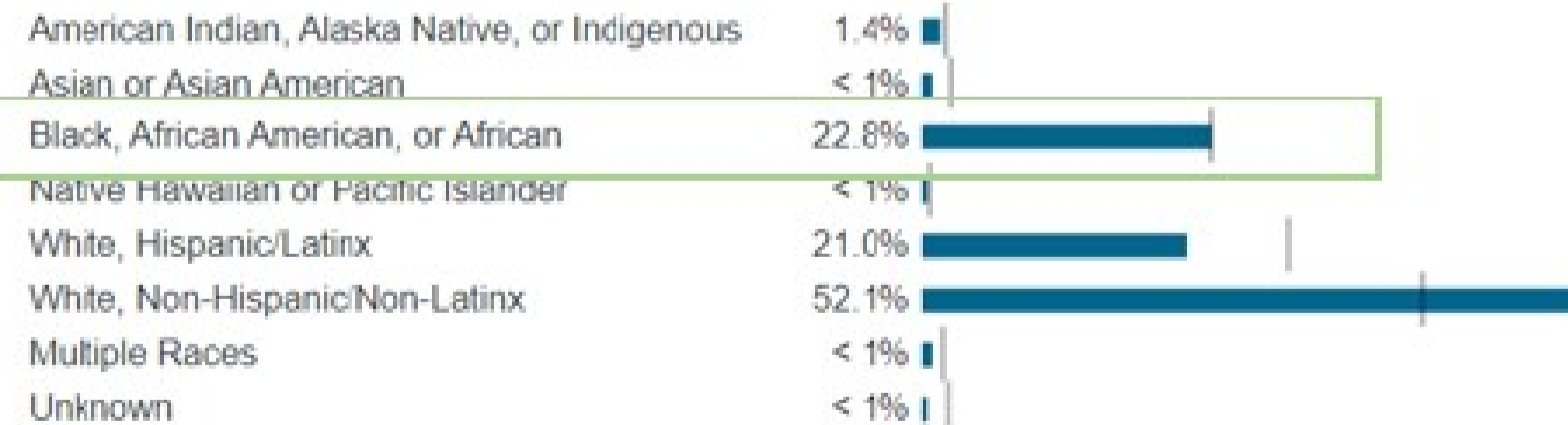
### White, Non-Hispanic/Non-Latinx

**37.7%** (n = 140) moved into Permanent Housing destinations  
**35.1%** (n = 437) in the System

**28.8%** (n = 418) in the System

### Asian or Asian American

**< 1%** (n = 2) moved into Permanent Housing destinations  
**2.2%** (n = 32) in the System

### White, Non-Hispanic/Non-Latinx

**52.1%** (n = 114) moved into Permanent Housing destinations  
**39.8%** (n = 576) in the System
