1. Center Update/Ongoing Business:

- a. BC update EIT Group update The CAL Chiefs/FIRESCOPE <u>Fire Operations Technology Summit at ESRI</u> will be January 23-25, 2024, this is a good event for both FIRE and your IT to attend. GLN will be hosting a FIRESTATS class, email was sent and there are limited spots available.
 - VFCC additional agency inquiry An Area E City is interested in joining Verdugo.
 - ii. CityGate update Verdugo has engaged with a contractor to conduct an assessment and strategic plan for Verdugo. The project is under review to focus on tiered dispatch and new City onboarding.
 - iii. One FCO is in training with another due to start training in a few weeks. A third is in backgrounds, and we just received a new requisition so another can begin backgrounds soon.
- b. Center Manager update Garrett
 - i. Type codes have been added to TC mobile version. This allows individuals to get notifications on their phone based on incident types and is set up by groups. Currently testing a command to allow size-ups and knockdown times to display on TC.

- ii. Thank you to SGB, ALH, & MPK for assistance with procession for West Covina officer who passed away. Verdugo was able to help West Covina dispatch by staffing their center for the night so their dispatchers could get the night off.
- iii. Working with GPD to set up our backup/disaster recovery (DR) site. Previously the DR was at BPD.

c. Technology Update:

- i. Mobility Upgrade The Mobility software on the MDTs will soon be upgraded. We have begun pushing out required software for the upgrade. With many software upgrades coming to the MDTs, it is important to keep them connected to the network. There are 44 MDTs that have been off the network for over 10 days, 13 for over 6 months.
- d. Finance/Data/Power BI
 - i. Gor is now working PT on Fridays and has updated the Power BI.
 - ii. Replacement of Gor will be focused on someone with analytics abilities. The process was slowed due to staffing changes at the GFD but is now back on track.

2. Old Business:

- a. Tablet Command
 - i. Two-way Status Ambrose, we are still awaiting a quote from Peraton is now expected by end of November.
 - ii. Tablet Command Training Group Hatch, The TC training group met last week and established initial guidelines and direction. Training group update- live training to record and send to each agency, adding new basic templates as well. Next months follow up meeting. Visit Corona fire to see how they use the 2-way platform on an android and ipad. BC Ambrose is going to make arrangements for a visit to Corona Fire.
 - iii. Tablet Command Radio quote approved; radio equipment purchased. Radio shop needs to test.
- b. Smart Dispatch Sell/Ambrose

Chief Sell, Chief Ambrose and Dr.Loza are still working on updates for improved response matrix for type codes.

- i. Alarm Response Data/Type Code and Transport Update:
 Data still showing vast improvement in cutting down on unnecessary alarm responses. (Figure 1) Discussion of removing AU on HazMat and dispatch of specialized resources on initial dispatch.
- c. Area C BC training update Rueda
 Planning on January for a return of Chief Kelly and his 360 training class.
 Chief Rueda needs to finalize with instructor.
- d. Comm Plan Update Ambrose/Weddle

Hardware has been purchased by radio shop. Purposed Comm plan from ICI includes addition of new talk groups. Discussion details of the comm plan which will have significant radio changes. In the interim a second red channel will be assigned automatically upon any second alarm assignment starting

December 1st. The Comm Plan work group will be meeting in the upcoming weeks and welcomes any new interested members.

e. MCI Alarm Levels – Hatch/Zanteson

Chief Hatch and Chief Zanteson reviewed old Verdugo MCI policy and created a draft removing redundant DHS Policy 519 verbiage. Discussion about creating MCI alarm codes for all type codes. Jason G. will research CAD functionality. Marianne will be joining the work group. The goal is to simplify initial ordering of resources when there is a large number of patients.

3. New Business:

- a. CAD Change: GLN OE1317/Type 3 will no longer be automatically dispatched on Brush fires and must be requested.
- b. 2024 Task Force will be changed back to , second Tuesday 1000 to 1130

4. Significant Incidents:

Pasadena Hazmat incident- CAL-Tech student was mixing chemicals in his apartment. Units were on scene for 8 hours. No injuries or major effects.
