The Director of Community Development will render a final decision on or after **January 31, 2024** for the following project:

To construct a 795 square-foot addition at the rear of the existing one-story, 1,454 square-foot single-family house (built in 1938) with an attached 237 square-foot garage. The addition includes, removal and rebuild 320 square feet of the existing kitchen and dining room at the rear and construct a 475 square-foot addition at the rear, northwest portion of the house. The lot is 10,875 square feet located in the R1-II (Low Density Residential, Floor Area Ratio District II) zone.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The project is exempt from CEQA review as a Class 1 "Existing Facilities" exemption pursuant to Section 15301 of the State CEQA Guidelines because the proposed floor area addition to the existing house will not result in an increase of more than 50 percent of the floor area of the structure before the addition in an area where all public services and facilities are available and is not in an environmentally sensitive area.
