

City Manager's Weekly Report No. 154

March 15, 2024

1. Recap of City Council Meeting

At their March 12th meeting the City Council took the following actions:

- Appropriated \$3M and \$4M for the South Central Avenue and the North Glendale Avenue Multimodal and Transportation Improvements Project; respectively.
- Authorized entering into a Professional Services Agreement for landscape architectural design services for the Pacific Park/Edison Artificial Turf Replacement Project.
- Accepted \$7,200 in ARPA funding from LA County Aging and Disabilities Department for Supportive Services Program.
- Directed staff on nomination process for individuals to Boards and Commissions and to revise nominating panel of Civil Service Commission vacancy.
- Voted to designate Councilmember Kassakhian as voting delegate and Councilmember Najarian as alternate representatives for the 2024 SCAG General Assembly taking place on May 2, 2024.
- Receives an update on Scholl Canyon Landfill Closure and requested another report with more details in the future.
- Voted to agendize a review of the Mayoral Selection Rotation Policy and a motion remove Subsection (H) from the Municipal Code regarding Mayoral Selection Rotation Policy.
