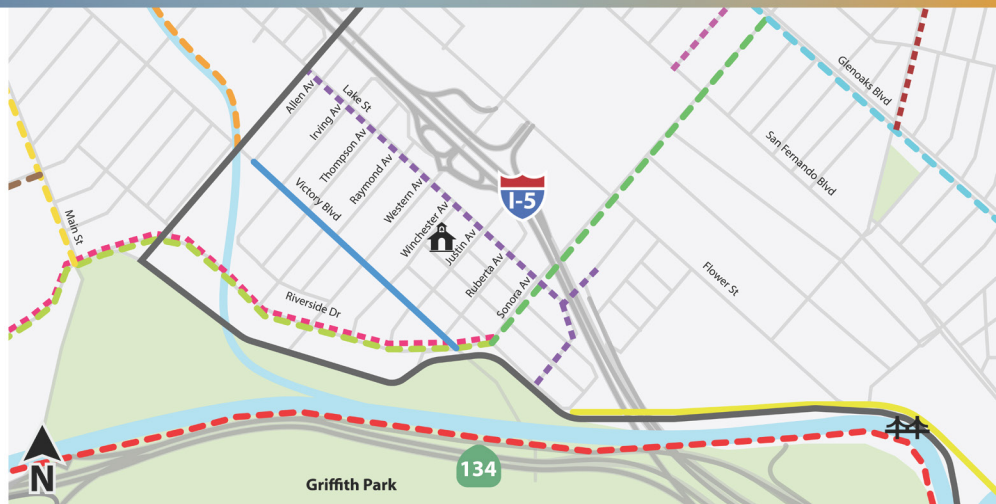
Victory Boulevard Complete Streets Project

The City of Glendale is working toward active transportation solutions that prioritize safety, add connectivity between the Burbank Channel Bikeway, Glendale Narrows Riverwalk, the future Garden River Bridge, and the Los Angeles River Bike Path to enhance pedestrian accessibility and promote regional bicycle network connections.

Project Overview

The City of Glendale conducted a feasibility study of Victory Boulevard that identified four potential alternatives to improve safety for cyclists and pedestrians, while maintaining traffic flow. The four alternatives will be presented to the community during this outreach effort and aim to enhance the transportation infrastructure of Glendale for all users.
