- b. Center Manager update – Garrett
 - i. Jason is attending PSAP meeting today which will cover Next Gen 911 and GIS related to new OES phone system.
 - c. Technology Update:
 - i. CAD Updates – Mobility, CommandPoint, and Viewpoint are due to be updated. Most updates are performed early morning with little to no down-time. Major updates will be communicated in advance.
 - ii. Server OS Updates – We will begin scheduling 1 week per quarter for server OS updates. There will be brief intermittent outages of all services during that week.
 - iii. Station Alerting and Recorder – Servers need to be moved off old domain, there may be some downtime.
 - iv. Disaster Recovery (DR) Site is fully up and running at GLN PD.
 - d. Finance/Data/Power BI
 - i. Gor is now working PT on Fridays and has updated the Power BI.
 - ii. Replacement of Gor in process.
 - e. GIS
 - i. Working on re-establishing AVL CAD once the ESRI GeoServer licensing issue has been resolved GeoServer license is updated to expire on 09/24/2025.
 - ii. Upgrade to ArcGIS 11.1 on hold until ESRI issues a security patch for recently found software vulnerability.
 - iii. Working with City of Pasadena to integrate its AVL tracks into the Tablet Command application.
2. Old Business
- a. Tablet Command
 - i. Two-way Status – Ambrose, quote received and is being reviewed. Jason Pfau is leading the tech review of the quote and will be setting up a meeting with TC. He found several items in the plan which need clarification.
 - ii. Tablet Command Training Group – Hatch. Admin training is scheduled January 16. Contact Chief Hatch if interested. They will be going over the global templates and forms. Chief Stavros inquired as to whether TC could have an option to “mirror” active calls for training purposes.
 - iii. Tablet Command Radio – The radios now appear on TC mobile and are still in test. Gordon Arnold reports that they are gradually getting all the equipment but were delayed with the TICP update. First impressions of the interface are very good and should be online soon.
 - b. Smart Dispatch – Sell/Ambrose – meeting scheduled with San Diego, Long Beach, and Metro Net
 - c. Area C BC training update – Rueda, no update.
 - d. Comm Plan – Ambrose. Memo and SOG attached.
 - e. MCI Alarm – Zanteson – the MCI work group has finished the draft and will get the final version for approval to Task Force prior to the February meeting for vote.
