Presentation: **Life Priority, The Addition of the Fourth Engine Company** by Captain Justin Pagliuso/Pasadena Fire Department

'Why are we sending the same that we send to a residential structure fire to a high-rise fire.' PAS augmented their response model for a high-rise fire to add 5 engines and an additional BC and then started looking at their residential model based of off life priority and reinforce the search component of the operation mindset. In doing that, they decided that a 4<sup>th</sup> engine was warranted on their initial responses and have been collecting data to support the decision.

- c. Technology Update:
  - i. Server OS Updates Happening this week. There will be brief intermittent outages of all services during this week.
