**DEP Sell (PAS)** - Two Pierce engines being outfitted, 3 new RA's due in August and one in September to rotate in to the fleet. **DEP James (PAS)** - currently hiring lateral FF's with 5 going to backgrounds. Open FF recruitment brought 650 applicants and PAS will be interviewing over 350 for an October academy. 2 Engineers will be promoted from the recent exam.

BC Weddle (MPK) - Status quo. Nothing new to report.

**DEP Cerwin (ARC)** – Captains exam on April 7<sup>th</sup>, need one more BC for exam (WCV AC Browne volunteered)

**DEP Stavros (GLN)** – 6 currently in FF academy, new ladder truck in fabrication, will be going to civil service for a Deputy Chief and Engineer bulletin. Squad 21 with limited transport abilities will be deployed this week for specific call types. The goal is to reduce the call load on downtown engines. SQ21 will be a 24 hour unit staffed if there are personnel signed up (no force hires). The plan is to fully staff once the academy recruits hit the line in July.

**BC Brown (ALH) -** 5 probationary FFs, Cadet will be starting PM school (paid weekly, similar to PAS model), finished the 6-City MCI drill, New T71 on track, new BC rig delayed by vendor.
