

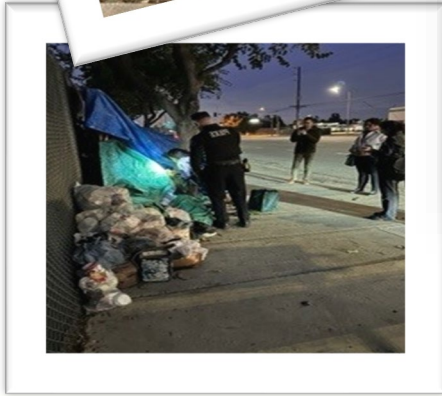

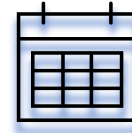

Mobile devices were used in to record survey responses.



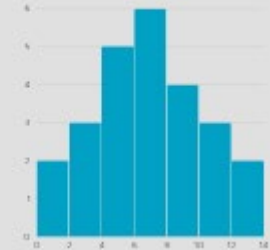

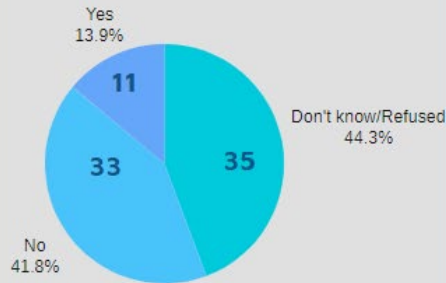

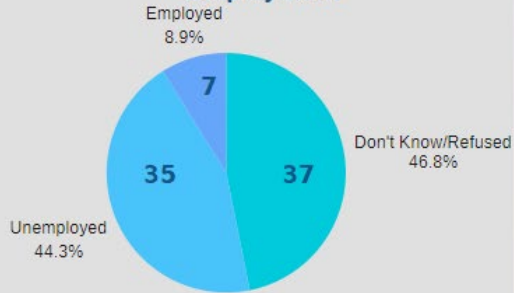

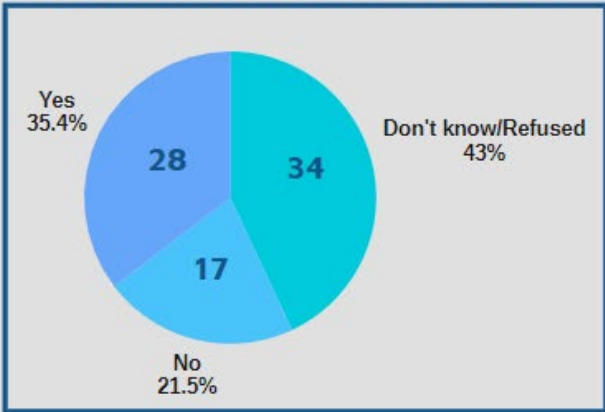

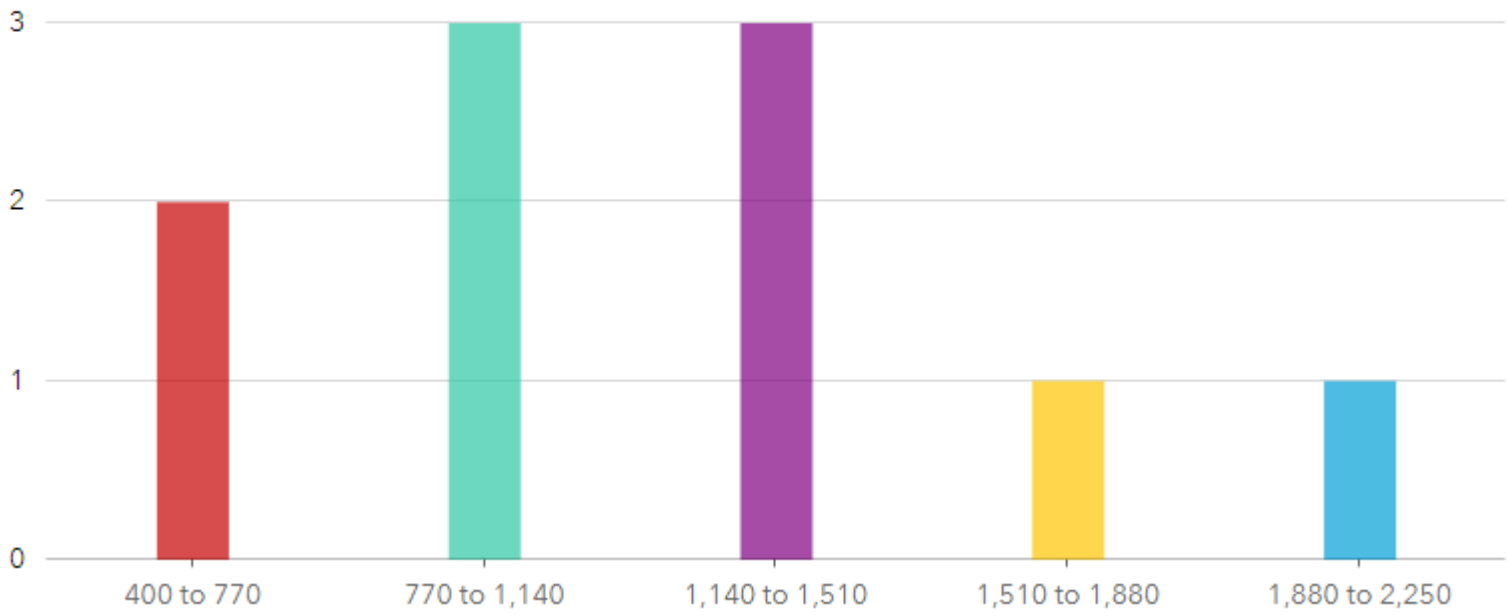

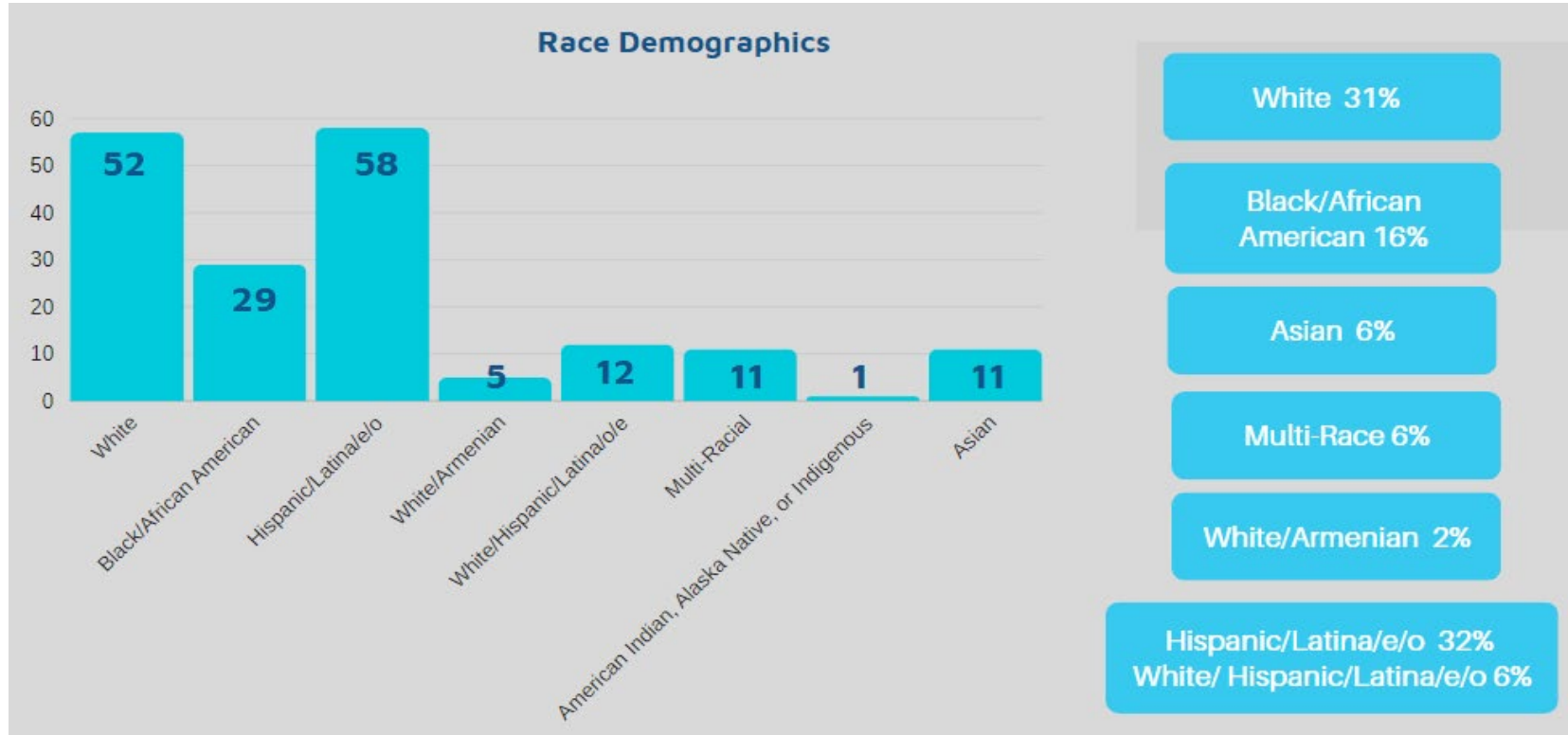

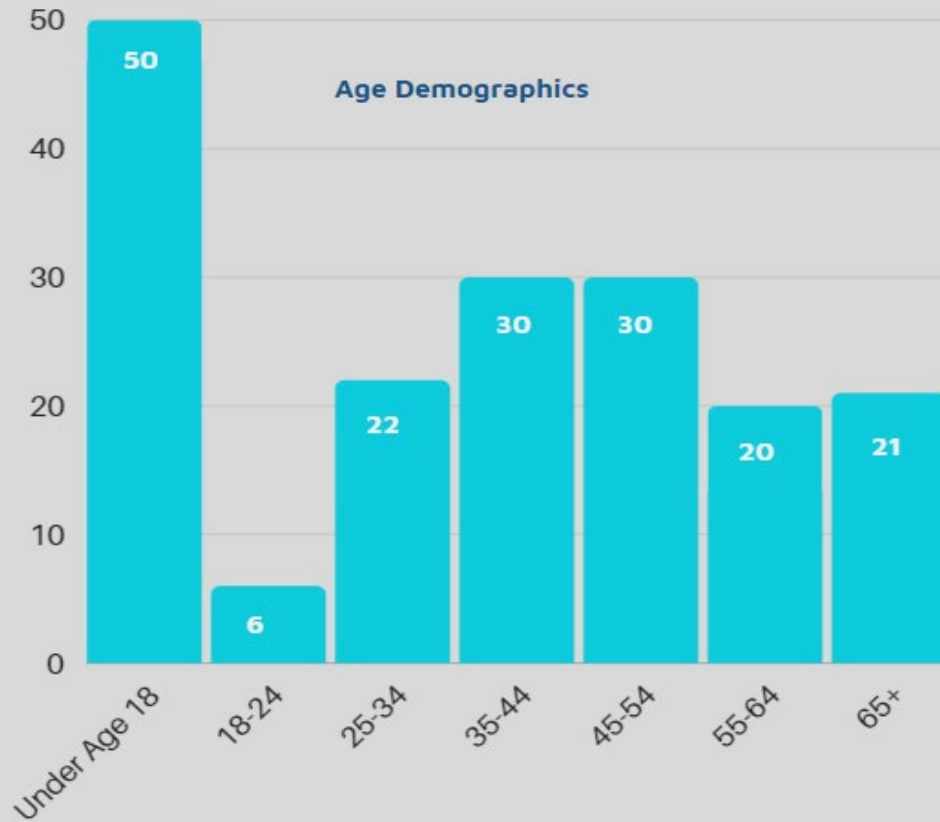
Column Bar Pie Map

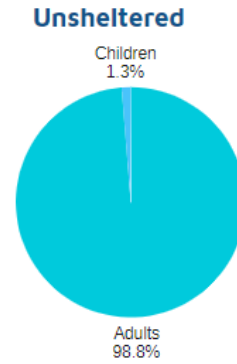

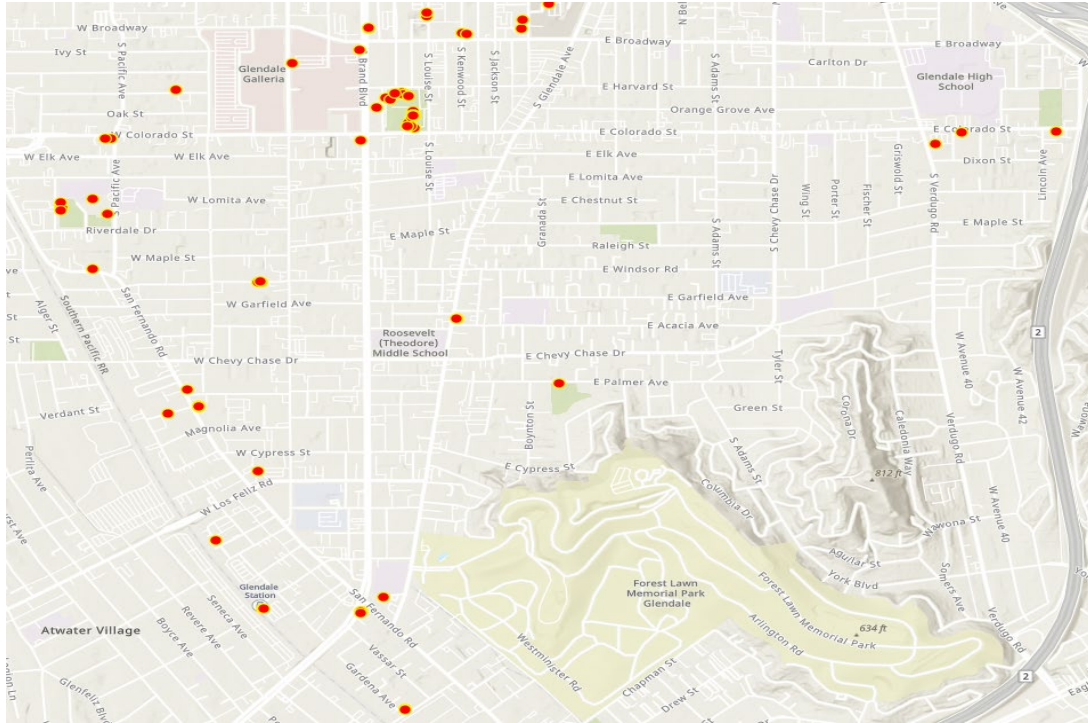

Next Steps

GLENDALE CONTINUUM OF CARE'S FOCUS...

- Through the coordination of the CES, work closely with Ascencia, Home Again LA, LA Family Housing, and Village Family Services to expand resources for homeless individuals, families, youth and other sub-population groups to secure housing and supportive services.
- Continue to work strategically to re-prioritize available funds to reallocate programs that are no longer HUD's priority to maintain its competitive status and continue to secure renewal and new funding.
